SENATOR CLARK: I think Senator Barnett may have the answer now.

SENATOR BARNETT: Senator Clark, I do have the answer. If you'll turn to page 76 section 13 I can read it to you. When the Department of Roads or local authority determines by an investigation that certain vehicles in addition to those specified in this section cannot with safety travel at the speeds provided in this act, the Department of Roads or local authority may restrict such vehicle's speed limit on highways under their jurisdiction and post proper and adequate sign.

SENATOR CLARK: Well, I'm still not sure that they're going to be able to do this without a long drawn out affair. If it's going to take that, I'd like to make the application for it now with the Department of Roads. That's what I'm trying to get at. I do want that reduced this summer.

SENATOR BARNETT: I think your application is well taken, I hope they adhere to it.

SENATOR CLARK: Thank you.

SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion on the committee amendment? Senator Barnett, do you care to close? Does the chairman of the committee care to close? I guess not. A voice vote is sufficient. Those in favor say aye, those opposed no. The committee amendments have been adopted. Chair recognizes Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. Chairman, I'd move that LB 45 be advanced to E & R as amended.

SPEAKER: Chair recognizes Senator Stull.

SENATOR STULL: I would like to add the emergency clause.

SPEAKER: There's a motion to add the emergency clause. Any discussion of this? Senator Duis, your light's on. Did you care to speak on this? If not, Senator Nore.

SENATOR NORE: The emergency clause should be added so that we can see what a disaster we're getting into.

SPEAKER: Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, I'd have to object to that and I'd ask for Senator Stull to withdraw the motion. We do have an operative date on the bill. January 1, 1974.

SPEAKER: Chair recognizes Senator Stull.

SENATOR STULL: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, if this is a good bill, why shouldn't we get it implemented as soon as possible?
