CLERK: 25 ayes, no nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion is adopted, and Stahmer amendment then is struck to 435. We now need a motion to move the bill on.

SENATOR NORE: Mr. Chairman, I move that we advance LB 435 to E&R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Motion now is to readvance LB 435 as amended. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered, the bill as amended is advanced. Do we have other motions on the desk?

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Yes, we got some committee confirmations here. Before we do that, Chair would like to announce we have some visitors here in the South Balcony that look like they're enjoying activities here this morning. We have 15 Third and Fourth Grade students from Surprise No. 1 Rural School District, is that right? It says Surprise 1 R, is that first one, the rural, good. Alright, from Surprise, Nebraska, that's Senator Schmit's district and I think it's Mrs. Lichliter, is the instructor. We're delighted to have you here today and we have 22 Grade School students from the 95 Rural School District at Winside, Nebraska and 5 adults up there, very good. They're from Senator Murphy's district and they're seated in the South Balcony and their instructor is Mrs. Gladys Reichart. We're delighted to have you also today as visitors to the Nebraska Unicameral Legislative Chamber and to the Capitol City and to the Capitol Building which, of course, still remains as one of the 10 architectural achievements of the world. Now then, we have some legislative confirmations here. Well, first before we do that, we'll take up 311 on select file.

CLERK: We have a motion to unbracket LB 311 on select file. Signed Senator Carpenter.

PRESIDENT: Alright, motion is to unbracket 311 on select file. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: The other day I made a motion to bracket it and the problem has been eliminated. I now ask unanimous consent to unbracket it and let the bill move forward.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to unbracketing 311? Hearing none, so ordered, the bill is unbracketed. Do you just want to leave it set on select file, Senator Carpenter?

SENATOR CARPENTER: No I move it from select file to E&R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Now the motion is to advance LB 311. Is there a need for discussion?

CLERK: Mr. President the, all amendments appear to have been adopted on the bill so there's nothing left to do on it except advance it.
