

request on the desk here to take up a bill. Let's see what happens.

CLERK: Mr. President, I ask unanimous consent to consider 149.

PRESIDENT: That was at the head of our list here anyway to start off this afternoon.

CLERK: 149?

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to hearing, are there any objections to taking up 149 at this time? No objections, we will. Stand by just a minute. All right, we're on 149. Has the bill been read?

CLERK: Reads title of 149. There are committee amendments, Mr. President, by Senator Schmit's agricultural committee.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: I understand this is very controversial so we just as well put it off because we'll never be able to get anything done with it today so, I move we not take it up at this time.

PRESIDENT: Your motion--I'm sorry, Senator Kremer, your motion was to pass it at this time, right?

SENATOR KREMER: My motion is to pass over it.

PRESIDENT: All right, motion is to pass over the bill. Are there objections to passing over 149? Hearing none, so ordered. Bypass that. The assistant clerk is writing a list of bills up here that is all that we have apparently in our hands that might be noncontroversial. I guess I can only invite you to copy down the list, to go through them, to make your own conclusions as to whether, if any of them are your bills or not whether they are controversial or noncontroversial. The chair can't make that decision for you. So roughly the list is this, if you want to take it down, if you'll follow me, 131 would be Senator Snyder's bill, 180--excuse me, 484 that's the Executive Board's bill, 484, next would be 187 Senator Kremer's bill, then 377, then 315, 299, 485, 490. Let's see what develops after we at least move on that far.

CLERK: Mr. President, we have a request to unanimously consent to bracket LB 275 on General File. This is not on the list but Senator Fowler would like to bracket the bill on General File. 275.

PRESIDENT: Senator Fowler's asking to bracket 275 on where? General File? Are there objections to bracketing 275 on General File? Hearing none, so ordered. The bill is bracketed. Senator Syas, your light is on, for what purpose did you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR SYAS: Well, all I wanted to say and there's no motion, but if the chair feels that unless we can stay in our seats for 25 votes we might as well adjourn. Because if we're going to do like we have on the last couple of votes where somebody will have to be hunted for every time we go to vote we might as well forget it.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator Syas. Next bill up as far as the chair is concerned if we're going to be in action here is LB 131, that's Senator Snyder's bill. What's your pleasure, Senator Snyder.
