SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. Chairman, I'd like to be excused the rest of the afternoon.

PRESIDENT: All right, are there objections to Senator Barnett's absence? Hearing none, so ordered. Senator Savage asking to be excused also. Are there objections to Senator Savage's absence? Hearing none, so ordered. Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: I make a motion we read what's on the desk and adjourn till Monday morning at 9:00.

PRESIDENT: All right, stand by. We have a bill on the desk here. We have LB 490 with the committee amendments and then Senator Kremer has amendments to the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kremer, go ahead with your amendment to amend the committee amendments.

SENATOR KREMER: Well, Mr. Chairman, I'm going to have to move that we pass over this bill. There are some amendments that have been offered to the committee that I have not had time to put them together. They have to do with the, with the disassembling of certain highway signs and the responsibility of an electric company being reimbursed for the expense of taking them down. I'm not prepared to take up those amendments so I move the bill be passed over.

PRESIDENT: Passing over the bill. All right, Senator Keyes, by way of clarification, the chair's going to rule that I can't accept your motion which would be to adjourn when it's tied to an action on the desk here and so forth. You can make it as a separate motion and that's fine and I'm sure that's not going to work a difficulty but the chair's also going to observe that I actually had, I actually have I suppose some commitment to Senator Kelly here in that he was next in line with his 341 that he's reassured me is not controversial. I don't know what we do beyond that point but at least we're going to take Senator Kelly's bill, then we'll see what develops. All right, Senator Kelly, that's 341. Clerk will read the bill. We bypassed 490 now.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, members of the body. This is a noncontroversial bill that would, took up on a Friday afternoon about three weeks ago. Senator Carpenter thought that it had some maybe dodging of taxes...

PRESIDENT: Let's read the title, Senator Kelly.

CLERK: Reads title to LB 341.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, I move we advance LB 341 to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: Further discussion of the bill? Question is, shall LB 341 be advanced from General File to E & R Initial? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Somebody back there punch Senator Anderson's green, would you? Thank you. Is there one more vote on the floor? All right, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, no nays, 24 not voting. Mr. President, there are some matters on the desk.

PRESIDENT: Bill is advanced. Go ahead.

CLERK: Reads reports.
