

PRESIDENT: Go ahead.

SENATOR KELLY: In line with the previous discussion on 449, what does our fiscal analyst say regarding 510?

SENATOR STAHMER: Fiscal analyst said it had a fiscal impact. It does not have a direct General Fund fiscal impact but indirectly it will have an impact until we know exactly what we are going to do on capital and revenue sharing.

SENATOR KELLY: Will or will not the fiscal analyst leave it off from our list?

SENATOR STAHMER: Well, the fiscal analyst is trying to do what we instruct him to do and I pity his job, see, because I think he is doing a good job and I am not trying to take fix on our staff. I think they are doing an excellent job. I am saying technically right now it has no direct General Fund impact but indirectly it does until we know what we are going to do with capital construction. As an example, the Budget Committee adopted some recommendations, the total, the net affect of which would be about five or six million General Fund appropriation, two or three million Cash Fund, some millions in Revenue Sharing funds. All of these add up in a sum total and if you have 1.3 million more or less from any source, you are going to talk 1.3 million more or less in General Funds. If we were not going to consider any other bills except this bill, then fine. We could go ahead and pass it but I think we are going to consider other bills and that is my point. I don't really think we know where we stand.

SENATOR KELLY: Well, I want that swimming pool but I also want to follow the procedures that we are now following and I would rely on the fiscal analyst as of now. Would that be a correct procedure for me to follow?

SENATOR STAHMER: Well, the fiscal impact both...if you want to interpret it for yourself and vote accordingly. He said there is no General Fund impact but there is a fiscal impact.

PRESIDENT: Thank you.

SENATOR KELLY: Thank you, Senator Stahmer.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: We had a motion which we have discussed previously. The fiscal staff, as best they can, is going by this motion. Therefore, 510 is on the list as having no fiscal impact. That is the only answer I can give.

PRESIDENT: Senator Whitney. I might add that the motion before the body is to bracket LB 510. That's the only motion here. Senator Stahmer has already closed. I called that to the attention of the body and we still are asking questions and continuing the discussion. The chair is in a very unenviable position in trying to limit the discussion here. That's the only motion before this body. The question is shall the...LB 510 be bracketed
