The Chair is in a very unenviable position in trying to limit the discussion here. That's the only motion before this body. Question is, shall the b--LB 510 be bracketed on final reading? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Chair would rule that this motion takes 25 votes in order to bracket LB 510 on final reading. Question is, shall LB 510 be bracketed on final reading at this time? Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 3 ayes, 24 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Alright, the motion is lost. We'll proceed with the final reading of LB 510. Before we do that, the Chair would like to announce that we did have and unfortunately it came during the time of the long, the long, the reading of the long bill 494, but we had 29 Grade School Students from Plattsmouth Elementary School and four sponsors. Their teacher was Mrs. Peacock. They were in the North Balcony and they are from Senator Cal Carsten's district and I specifically excused him in order to be able to at least meet them in the Rotunda so that they could feel that they had been greeted by their Senator. Proceed with the final reading of LB 510.

CLERK: Engross Legislative Bill 510. (read) LB 510

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor will vote aye. All those opposed will vote no. Once again, have you all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 41 ayes, no nays, 8 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed with the emergency clause attached. Do we have any resolutions on the desk?

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are there any bills for introduction?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Ready for the consideration of bills on select file. Senator Cavanaugh in the chamber?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Can you give me the page number, Mr. Clerk?

PRESIDENT: Stand by.

CLERK: 1494.

PRESIDENT: 1494? Senator Lewis, for what purpose do you rise?

CLERK: and 1503.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: (mike off) Chairman, I would request again that we bypass 172 on select file.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lewis asking unanimous consent to bypass 172 on select file. Are there objections? Hearing none, so ordered, the bill is bypassed then. Begin with 454, Senator Cavanaugh.
