CHAPLAIN: Prayer.

PRESIDENT: Roll call.

CLERK: Senator Snyder asked to be excused until 10:00 o'clock.

PRESIDENT: Have you all indicated your presence? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Are there corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President (read corrections). That's all Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are there corrections from the floor? If not the Journal will stand as corrected. Do we have notices of committee hearings or reports?

CLERK: A reference report, Mr. President (read)

PRESIDENT: Do we have any other reports?

CLERK: No that's all.

PRESIDENT: Any other communications?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Three bills on final reading this morning. The Chair understands they are 55, 349 and 515 with the emergency clause. As soon as we can clear the floor, get the Senators in their seats, we'll begin the final reading of LB 55. Once again, we are trying to get the Senators in their seats. Sometimes that poses as a difficult problem. Thank you Sergeant at Arms, the Chair appreciates your efforts over there. Alright, I think we're ready for the final reading of LB 55. Clerk will read the bill. Attention please, final reading of LB 55.

CLERK: Read.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Once again the Chair would ask if you have all voted. Clerk will record.

CLERK: (mike off) roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. Attention please, to final reading of LB 349.

CLERK: Legislative Bill 349. (read) LB 349.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Is, is he through with the roll call?

PRESIDENT: No, not yet, stand by. Okay, go ahead, finish the call.

CLERK: 45 ayes, no nays, 4 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Very good, the bill is passed with the emergency clause attached. Senator Carpenter, for what purpose do you rise?
