SENATOR FELLMAN: When..Mr. President, members of the Legislature, when LB 358 was on General File a few days ago, an amendment was passed adding to it a provision requiring stricter bus dri..on the drivers licensing for drivers of school buses. Subsequent to that, I learned that there is some litigation involving the bill itself, an earlier bill in the last session and I merely would like to add the severability clause so that if in case a portion of this decided in court to be unconstitutional, this other portion can remain in effect.

SPEAKER: Any discussion about adding the severability clause. If not, are you ready to vote? All those in favor of adding the severability clause vote aye. Those opposed vote no. The clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: The severability clause is added. Now, what will you do with the bill, Senator Cavanaugh?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 358 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER: All those in favor of advancing the bill as amended say aye. Those opposed no. The bill is advanced. Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 531.

SPEAKER: Any discussion. All those in favor of adopting the amendments say aye. Those opposed no. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 531 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER: Is there any discussion? All those in favor of advancing the bill as amended say aye. Those opposed no. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, now I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 528.

SPEAKER: Is there any discussion? All those in favor of the adoption of the amendments to LB 528 say aye. Opposed no. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move...

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, we have some amendments offered by Senator Burbach to LB 528. Amendments read.
