Clerk reading.

SPEAKER: Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: Mr. President and Members of the Legislature, let me read to the body a note sent by Bill Plotsak possibly: "Mr. Beermann: LB 528 advanced to E&R and still doesn't have the amendments. I gave them to Burbach once and you gave him another copy too. If the bill passes in the present form, it will serve to defeat much of what we accomplished in LB 224. What now? LB 529 is in the same boat! I move for the adoption of the amendments.

SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion? Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Did we have an explanation of the amendments?

SPEAKER: Well, Senator Burbach, did we have an explanation?

SENATOR BURBACH: It's a matter of record keeping is what the amendments are for and under LB 224, that was a record keeping bill, in an order for the Auditing Department to take care of the microfilming and so forth, offices filing by roll form of microfilm pursuant to section so and so--

SENATOR DUIS: Thank you, sir. I just wanted to be sure that the record keeping did not apply to the individual who was involved--it's the department, is that correct?

SENATOR BURBACH: That's right.

SENATOR DUIS: Thank you.

SPEAKER: Are you ready for the question? Question is shall the Burbach amendments be adopted? All those in favor say aye. Those opposed now Mr.--just a minute, we'll have to--machine vote on this. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, no nays, Mr. President, on motion to adopt.

SPEAKER: The amendments are adopted. Any further amendments?

CLERK: None.

SPEAKER: Now Senator Cavanaugh, what will you do with the bill?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 528 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossing.

SPEAKER: Are you ready for the question? All those in favor of advancing the bill as amended say aye. Those opposed no. The bill is advanced.
