times to have a full committee and as suggested, ahead of time to the members of the committee that this is going to the purpose of the meeting was to, for that specific purpose and then we have taken that up. Now Mr. President, I'd like then since I have unanimous consent, do I to give the names of all of these persons?

SPEAKER: Well, I have a couple lights on up here. Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, and members of the legislature, I'm wondering this committee on committee functions to a large degree in the same capacity that our other standing committees do and I'm wondering if, like Senator Carpenter has said, that maybe we should not only have the report of the confirmed appointments, but also a report from the committees on those that were not confirmed. We do get a report from individuals on the committee from time to time, but I don't believe that the body as a whole gets a report on those and I, to a degree I agree with Senator Carpenter, I think that we should have that report, so that we may understand why or how the committee came to their decision. I don't, personally don't think this would be an unreasonable request, if it has to be made in the form of a request. Would Senator Whitney care to answer that?

SENATOR WHITNEY: Thank-you, Senator Carsten, I shall bring that point up at this committee of committee's hearing.

SPEAKER: The chair is going to recognize, two more speakers have had their lights on and I ask you to keep it short and then I'm going to rule, all further discussion out of order because they don't pertain to the nominees here and if you want to discuss, what the committee should be doing why there is a time and a place for that. Senator Syas, then Senator Duis.

SENATOR SYAS: Well, all I want to say to this legislature about the committee on committees. I've served on it several times, and for those of you who that do not, or have not, and I won't say it is a great opportunity because I think it is the worst thing you can serve on. I'm awful glad I'm not on it, but the point I want to make, the committee on committees meets during the noon hour and is to Senator Nore, or anyone else, that you never get a full membership of any committee on committee, I want to be there to raise the flag on that particular day, because I've gone through it time and time again and I don't, I think only once or twice have I ever been on a committee on committee where everybody is there. Now all I'm trying to say is if you start requiring the committee on committee to have a, have everyone there before they can take action, your going to immobilize the committee and they are going, they can't, won't be able to take action all session, on any committee on committee and that is not criticism but that is the way the ball is.

SPEAKER: Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, members of the legislature, maybe I can stop this right here and now, on page 16 of your rule book, subparagraph, parentheses small d, all nominations made to the legislature by the Governor, requiring confirmation by the legislature shall be referred to the committee on committees and the same procedure shall be followed as governs the handling of other matters before standing committees, unless the legislature shall other direct, other wise direct a unanimous vote. So there is no question about
