Senator Duis, any objection at all to that? It is so ordered. Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, for the purpose of expediency, LB 588 merely adds the emergency clause. I would ask unanimous consent to take it up right now on general file and we'll get it out of the road and we won't have any discussion I'm sure. 588.

SPEAKER: Is there any objection to that? He, Senator Duis wants to take that up immediately. It only amounts to adding the emergency clause. Is there any objection? Senator Marvel, did you wish to speak on that? Alright, if there's no objection it is so ordered.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I would ask that 588 be advanced to Enrollment & Renew initial and it has, needs no explanation. It's merely adding the emergency clause to the bill that was introduced.

SPEAKER: Any discussion? Those in favor of advancing the bill which just adds the emergency clause on it, vote aye. Those opposed vote nay. Senator Whitney voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Whitney voting aye.

SPEAKER: Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, no nays, 19 not voting.

SPEAKER: LB 588 advances to E&R for review. The Chair wishes to announce there are 77 students in the Sixth Grade from Paddock Lane, City of Beatrice. You can't put an A bill on until they're processed but this gives you some picture of what's involved in the A bill situation and this is as per the general request of the Legislature and, and so if you to know what the source is, it's the, we had it made up to be passed out.

SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and Members of the Legislature. I'd like unanimous consent at this time to take up LB 538. It's a bill that has to do with environmental control council and it's important that it be passed this session and it won't, it should not be controversial.
