PRESIDENT: Nope.

SENATOR GOODRICH: We just voted on it.

PRESIDENT: That's right, that was just for the two resolutions that Senator Rasmussen had at this time, wanting a separate suspension of the rules to handle this. Alright, question is shall the rules be suspended so that these names can be added to the resolution? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. This is just a technical suspension. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, no nays, 19 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Rules suspended. Now, Senator Barnett, do you have a separate motion there on--

SENATOR BARNETT: No, I--

PRESIDENT: Was that in--the names will just be included in the suspension.

SENATOR BARNETT: Right, and I did ha--I have been trying to stand up for a request but if I'm out of order at this time, I would wait till the proper time. I want to bracket a bill that's up today.

PRESIDENT: Well, stand by with that, will you? For a little bit?

SENATOR BARNETT: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Alright. Now, Senator Carpenter, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Two days ago I indicated I would make a motion in order to consider all the A bills which are now on final reading and I make the motion now. That we consider them now.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to consider all A bills on final reading now. Senator Syas did you wish to be heard on the issue? Okay. Motion before the body is that we consider all the A bills at--on final reading at this time. Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: Wish to make only this comment; that we have passed out for your information, I think you got it yesterday, the present impact to A bills and I think the impact on the general fund is about \$8,000,000 and the total which includes general and federal funds, is about \$32,000,000. I have one other comment I'd like to make and that is that we should begin to think about when we consider the rest of the budget bills, there are four bills up there that--no there are five bills. There are the three bills having to do with deficiencies, are supplemental appropriations that the Governor asked for; 581, 582 and 583. There's also the capital construction budget, 256 and there is Legislative Bill 505, so I suggest when you consider motions such as this, you take a look at the, at the sheet that indicates the impact, you consider the fact that 581, 582, 583, 256 and 505 are yet to come up for consideration, hopefully before we adjourn.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Goodrich, then Senator Chambers, then Senator Syas.
