SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the bill be advanced from General File to E & R initial.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the bill? Senator Schmit did you wish to be heard? Question is shall LB246 then be advanced from General File to E & R initial. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Maybe I ought to ring my bell again. Have you all voted?

SENATOR CARPENTER: I ask for a call of the house.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter asked for a call of the house, the Clerk will clear the board. The next bell please indicate your preference for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Motion is for a call of the house. Once again, have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 16 Ayes, 0 Nays on the call of the house.

PRESIDENT: The motion prevails, we are now under a call of the house. The next bell please indicate your presence. We are under a call of the house gentlemen. Original motion under vote is the passage of LB246 with committee amendments from General File to E & R initial. 246. Senator Clark we are under a call of the house. Movement of 246 from General File to E & R initial. Salaries of state officials.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the call be raised.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to raise the call. All those in favor of raising the call vote aye, those opposed vote no. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 Ayes, 0 Nays and 24 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Call is raised.

CLERK: 26 Ayes on the original motion.

PRESIDENT: LB246 is advanced from General File to E & R initial then. This brings up for General File debate LB275.

CLERK: Read

PRESIDENT: Chair represents Senator Fellman.

FELLMAN: Mr. President, members of the legislature, I ask unanimous consent to withdraw the amendment submitted by myself and Senator Syas to this bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Fellman asking unanimous consent to withdraw the motion. Are there objections? Hearing none, so ordered then. The amendment is withdrawn. Are there other amendments to the bill?

CLERK: Yes.
