CLERK: Mr. President, the motion on LB 311A is to adopt the following amendment: (reads amendment) LB 311A

SPEAKER: Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President and Members of the body. I think I explained this previously. I think this would make this appropriation legal and conform with the Attorney General's opinion upon what we can and cannot do and I, therefore I move the amendment as it was read.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion? If not the motion is to adopt Stahmer amendment. Takes 25 votes. All those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote nay. Senator Simpson voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Simpson voting aye. Senator Car--ohhh.

SPEAKER: Have you all voted? Takes 25 votes to adopt. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, no nays, 24 not voting.

SPEAKER: Motion is adopted. Senator Cavanaugh, what shall we do with the bill?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 311A as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossing.

SPEAKER: --Second. Motion is to advance 311A. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. Is advanced. Now we need a unanimous consent motion to take up the other bills on select file. Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move unanimous consent to take up LB 45 on select file.

SPEAKER: Any objection? If not, so ordered. Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Are there specific amendments on there?

CLERK: Yes, on all three of them. The first one is LB 45.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Are there E&R amendments?

CLERK: They are E&R amendments, yes.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to LB 45.

SPEAKER: Of second? Motion is to adopt the E&R amendments to LB 45. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. Amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President I move LB 45 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossing.
