

CLERK: There are committee amendments Mr. President, offered by Senator Marvel's budget committee.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I move the adoption of the standing committee amendments for 581. There are two items involved. One is for Renal disease within the health department. They came before us when this bill was presented and said that they would like to have that \$110,000 deleted. All this money is general fund money. The second amendment has to do with the court system appropriations, Senator Luedtke and the original, the amount originally was \$295,000, 298,000. Mr. Dunlevy came in and said that they would need only \$275,000 so that the reduction is 23,000. Those are the two amendments in effect suggested by those that are affected, and I renew my motion to adopt the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the motion. Question is shall the committee amendments then be adopted. All those in favor, vote aye, those opposed say no. The committee amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have some further amendments offered by Senator Duis to amend the bill. (Read), signed Herbert J. Duis.

PRESIDENT: Is Senator Duis in the chambers? Are there other amendments then to the bill?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Is Senator Duis in the chamber? Senator Duis, we are ready for your motion here, on LB 581.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, members of the legislature, I've moved the adoption of the amendment. The amendment is merely on a cash fund basis in the implementation of the real estate act required that the cash fund be amended due to the additional money coming in and being put there and also would take care of a deficiency that was created in the giving of examinations during the last period and the cash fund from the department would take care of it and that is the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the motion? Question is, shall the amendment then be adopted? All those in favor of the Duis amendment, please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendment is adopted.

CLERK: There are no further amendments.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: May I ask Senator Marvel a question.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel will you yield?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Now what is the fiscal impact on this out of the general funds?

SENATOR MARVEL: It is roughly, with the amendments we have already adopted, \$604,663.00.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Now is this the bill that the Governor sent in to supplement what was in 359?

SENATOR MARVEL: No sir. This is the supplement to last years budget.
