PRESIDENT: It's the Chair's understanding the amount has not changed, Senator Kelly, it's the pro rata that has changed.

SENATOR KELLY: The committee amendment didn't change the amount of money either?

PRESIDENT: No. Excuse me, I can't answer that. Senator Marvel, his question is, did the committee amendments change the amount of money--

SENATOR KELLY: Senator Marvel, how much money are we voting for at this time?

SENATOR MARVEL: Okay. Do you have your, do you have your bill there?

SENATOR KELLY: Yes.

SENATOR MARVEL: Do you have the fiscal note which reads, which reads \$2,320,930? Find that? Down at the bottom. Our amendment, the committee amendment is the fiscal note on top which, which is \$1,095,170 so the battle is between the two figures.

SENATOR KELLY: And on the Duis amendment we're still voting for the \$1,000,000 figure?

SENATOR MARVEL: No, we're back to \$2,320,930.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: May I say this. I have just been visiting with Eldin Ehrlich here. The--this procedure, I believe, is necessary because we set the percentage and then when the money comes through from the gover--from the Federal Government over on select file I think, Senator Kelly, is when you're going to find the amount of money is set because they're going to come through apparently with the different allocation by the time we get over on select file. What we're setting here with the 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ % is the formula by which the money would be taken into consideration, that the Federal Government's bringing in.

PRESIDENT: Now Senator Stahmer, do you have a question of the Chair? Thank you sir. Question is shall the Duis amendment be adopted? All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say no. Question is shall the Duis amendment be adopted? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. You are voting on the Duis amendment to LB 505. The Duis amendment to LB 505. Chair would again ask, have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 7 nays to adopt.

PRESIDENT: Duis amendment is adopted. Are there other amendments now to 505 on the desk?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Alright, Senator Marvel, back to you then. Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: --Advance to E&R initial.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the bill? Question is shall LB 505 now as amended be advanced from general file to E&R initial? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Voting on the motion to advance LB 505 as amended. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.
