CLERK: Mr. President, we have unanimous consent request to consider LB 587 after LB 533. Signed, Senator Stull.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections? Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: I just wanted to ask a question. How much debate do you expect on this, Senator Stull? Thank you, I won't object.

PRESIDENT: That's after 533, is that correct? All right, move on to the General File discussion of LB 533. Clerk will read the title.

CLERK: Reads title of LB 533. There are numerous amendments, Mr. President. There are first amendments offered by the Standing Committee signed by Senator Warner, Chairman.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I believe, Mr. Clerk, I have amendments on the desk the first one of which is in lieu of the committee amendment. I want to point out that I had passed out some days ago amendments for 533 and yesterday I had those identical amendments passed out but broken down into three areas because I think there are essentially three areas of discussion on the bill and I would like to move the first one of those. Can you tell which one that is, Vince?

CLERK: I have one with a red circle. Is it just the encircled amendment that is being adopted?

SENATOR WARNER: No, but I passed up sheets, I had sheets like this yesterday.

CLERK: I don't seem to have that.

SENATOR WARNER: Well, I filed them there.

CLERK: Oh, okay, then you just want this other one disregarded?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Senator Syas.

SENATOR SYAS: I just want to say I think you got, before he can offer his other amendments, I think, I'm not kicking but I think you've got to dispose of the committee amendments first one way or the other. Now if he doesn't want them adopted, let him not adopt and

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator Syas. Senator Warner.

CLERK: The Warner amendment is in lieu of the Standing Committee amendment which would be an amendment to it.

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Syas, the bill as written, the motion is written to do just that. I have it in lieu of the committee amendment so then it's automatic. Now the first amendment is the one that has to do with the distribution of funds. Is that the one you have, Vince?

CLERK: Yes. I guess. It starts out on page 14 line 1?

SENATOR WARNER: Strike payment and insert payment the distribution of such funds?
