SENATOR CARPENTER: I don't want to ask for a Call of the House, Mr. President. Why don't the members vote to move the bills on.

PRESIDENT: All right, stand by. Okay, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay, 21 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Okay now, we have Senator Carpenter's motion which involves apparently three or four other bills here but the next order of business as the chair understood it was to go to LB 261, it was by unanimous consent this morning. The next bill on General File would be 261 and then we'll take up your motion on these others, Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I'm not too sure this won't take a lot of time.

PRESIDENT: All right, let's stand by. We'll see if Senator Schmit wants to yield.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I'll yield, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: You're going to yield for these bills then?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes, I will.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Carpenter, back to you

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move LB 529 be advanced to E & R for Initial with the understanding the amendments we offer on Select File and the discussion take place there.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter, I'm sorry, I thought the first one you offered was 526.

SENATOR CARPENTER: 526, yes.

PRESIDENT: Okay, any further discussion now? Motion is to advance LB 526 from General File. Senator Duis. He says that he's going to take them up on Select File.

CLERK: There are no committee amendments. There are other amendments.

PRESIDENT: All right, no committee amendments on 526. Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, it takes 25 votes to put an amendment on on Select File. I'd much prefer to have 526 immediately if I could because...

SENATOR CARPENTER: I yield, I yield.

PRESIDENT: I'm sorry, Senator Duis, I don't know. Are you objecting?

SENATOR DUIS: All right then let her go to Select File. I'll withdraw.

PRESIDENT: All right, the Clerk has to read the title.
