

SENATOR CARPENTER: You don't have to on select file.

PRESIDENT: You don't have to. They are going to suspend the rules, so that you won't have to do that. Tomorrow.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: We went through that the other day with Senator Lewis's bill. We went through that the other day on the resolution with Senator Lewis and we spent a half a day trying to figure out if we could suspend the rules or not. Or if we wanted to.

PRESIDENT: Just a minute, Senator Duis, do you want to give us some help here please.

SENATOR DUIS: The thing you are referring to Senator Richendifer, is suspending the rules for more than 1 day. Tomorrow morning I explained a little earlier, I would make a motion to suspend the rules for the day, in regard to select file, so that the bills on select file could be taken up in the same manner as that which they are taken up on general file.

PRESIDENT: Senator Richendifer, the chair, reassure you that almost all of the bills that we have advanced today, have been advanced with that understanding. Other than that, this couldn't have been accomplished for the bills to be moved off of general file. In order for us to move them off, this were the conditions that they were accepted under. I don't think you have a concern, if you would accept my word for it. All right now, Senator Mahoney. Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. President, I just get a kick out of that little Johnnie DeCamp and I just will go right to the thing. The committee amendments are not as innocent as they look. Your increasing beer and liquor taxes by that committee. That committee might be a fine committee, but in this particular amendment that you are sending over, you are going to be increasing and in this last minute and last, we did this last evening, with Senator DeCamp and Senator Carpenter both up in maneuvering, we can not have this because the committee amendments call for an increase and this would be a slick way of putting it over and already increasing it and having it attached and you know it is one hell of a time to take it back off.

PRESIDENT: All right, we're under discussion then. The question is shall the committee amendments to 127 then, be adopted. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. You are voting on the committee amendments to LB 127. Committee amendments to LB 127. Voting on the committee amendments to 127. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 12 to 10 Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right, the committee amendments are adopted. Now, what is your pleasure regarding the bill? Senator Carpenter. Motion now is to advance LB 127 as amended from general file to E & R initial. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Motion is to advance LB 127. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: 127 fails to advance. Now Senator Duis, you were next to speak, then Senator Waldron.

SENATOR DUIS: I just wanted unanimous consent to put 87 over on select file please.

PRESIDENT: Any objection to hearing 87? Any objections? Hearing none, so ordered. We'll take up LB 87.
