PRESIDENT: That's the chair's understanding. We do have...

SENATOR CARPENTER: All right. So the one you are voting on now has only one thing and that's to require the wholesalers of the liquor in the state of Nebraska to deliver their product at the same F.O.B. delivered price destination. That's all this amendment does.

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: A question of Senator Carpenter then.

PRESIDENT: All right. Senator Carpenter, will you yield?

SENATOR GOODRICH: Does it refer to each brand?

SENATOR CARPENTER: It's anything they sell.

SENATOR GOODRICH: For example, we are not requiring them to charge the same price for each brand?

SENATOR CARPENTER: The thing only depends on the weight of the container irrespective of the contents.

SENATOR GOODRICH: OK.

PRESIDENT: Now is there any further discussion of that particular amendment? The question is then shall the amendment be adopted. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I ask for a Roll Call vote. Every licensee in this state is interested in how the membership stands.....(inaudible)...all they have to do is talk.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter asking for a Roll Call vote. The clerk will clear the Board.

CLERK: Roll Call vote. 25 ayes, 14 nays, remainder not voting.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. We have one more amendment by Senator Carpenter to the bill.

CLERK: OK. Now there is another amendment offered by Senator Carpenter.

PRESIDENT: Read the amendment please.

CLERK: Allright. The amendment reads as follows: Read.

PRESIDENT: That's the amendment. Senator Carpenter. Do you want to speak on behalf of the amendment here.

SENATOR CARPENTER: This other amendment only does, it makes a few corrections which has nothing to do with the substance of the bill. The main necessity for that is to eliminate the dispensers from the bill in which it came out of the Committee with. This only says that the law is the same as it was. They don't have to hire a dispenser and have him licensed. That's all it does.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion now of that amendment? All right. The question is shall the amendment to 111 be adopted then. Those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The clerk will record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, 15 not voting.
