

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to amend LB 111 to amend..read. Signed, Senator DeCamp.

PRESIDENT: The chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, very simply the other day we adopted amendments to the bill which allowed bottle clubs to operate in much the same way as Class "C" licensees but we limited it only to counties above 5,500 population and I received several letters saying this is discriminatory and talked to some other Senators who wanted to change it, so this just makes the same law apply to all counties. You are just eliminating the population differential there. All counties would have their bottle clubs treated the same. I move adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The chair recognizes Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I have no objection. It'd only give the same advantage to all the counties without the 5400 restriction as far as population. The original reason for this was that some of the law enforcement officers felt that to allow these operations in the county which are basically land and no population might bring about more of a law enforcement problem than they desire to have. I don't think it is material, one way or the other. If it does that, why when we come back in January, we can undo it. Now in the other amendment, however, if this destination delivery doesn't work we will be back here in January. If it doesn't work, I will be the first one to help you people repeal it. So let's try it.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the amendment? The question is shall the DeCamp amendment be adopted to 111. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Voting on the DeCamp amendment to 111 on Select File. The clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, 20 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: The bill be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the bill? The question is shall LB 111 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor of advancing the bill please say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, the bill is advanced. This brings up discussion then of LB 581.

CLERK: Mr. President, the E & R amendments have been adopted. to Select File. The bill was laid over yesterday at the request of Senator Carpenter.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter, what is your pleasure regarding 581?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President, I think there is a number of amendments. May I ask Senator Marvel if he has an amendment.

CLERK: We thus far have no amendments.

SENATOR MARVEL: Well, I...I'd rather, if there is no objections, take up 582 first, then go back to 581. Does anybody object to this?

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to taking up 582 first, instead of 581. Hearing none, so ordered. We will take up 582.
