CHAPLAIN: Prayer.

PRESIDENT: Roll call. Please indicate your presence.

CLERK: Senator Anderson asked to be excused today.

PRESIDENT: Well, stand by. You have it and I don't. We are having a little difficulty adjusting the levels of the microphones here. Stand by..have you all indicated your presence? The clerk will record.

CLERK: A quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are there corrections for the Journal.
