SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move Mr. President, I move 111 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance LB 111. All those in favor of advancing the bill now please say aye. Those opposed say no. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 533.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to 533. All those in favor of the motion say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 533 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Motion now is to advance the bill. All those in favor of advancing the bill say aye. Those opposed say no. The bill as amended is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Senator Duis would like to be recognized I think.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I don't mean to interrupt here but I think I need to be excused probably for the rest of the day. We've got a real bridge problem out at Brady and I would like to speak to Senator Waldron, if I might and I just wanted to get that permission, if I might.

PRESIDENT: Yes. You are asking to be excused now, Senator Duis or do you want to carry on a conversation here or what?

SENATOR DUIS: Might I ask is 526 coming up this morning? I've been on the phone here practically all morning.

PRESIDENT: Yes. We are going to take every (inaudible)

SENATOR DUIS: OK. I'll wait until after 526 then. If I might be..I'm going out of the room. If 526 comes up, I will be in my office. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: All right. Thank you. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I want to elaborate on what Senator Duis is confronted with. There is more water in the North Platte river now than has been for some time. There is more water in around Casper and west of Casper than the history of the country. It is estimated that the river is going to rise beyond anything on the North Platte the people ever experienced and what's confronting the Senator from Gothenburg is going to confront everybody on the North Platte. This is really serious and eventually as it goes down, it accumulates in the North Platte until it dumps into the Missouri and I only want to alert every Senator who lives on the North Platte, whose district is whole or part, we're all in trouble and deep trouble.

PRESIDENT: Next is LB 187, Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Now move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 187.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 187. All those in favor of the motion say aye. Those opposed say no. The amendments are adopted.
