PRESIDENT: 378.

SENATOR SCHMIT: A copy of the amendment is on your desk.

PRESIDENT: You've discussed this with Senator Burbach? This motion is not in line with what we adopted early this morning relative to select file and that is to consider those four bills up there. It's fine if you can get unanimous consent but I want you to know that it in conflict with that earlier motion.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes, I did check with Senator Burbach first.

PRESIDENT: Okay. Alright. Senator Schmit is asking unanimous consent to take up--to return, was it, 378 from--

SENATOR SCHMIT: That's right.

PRESIDENT:--E&R for--to select file for specific amendment? Are there objections? Senator Keyes, are you objecting?

SENATOR KEYES: Not objecting, I'd like--

PRESIDENT: Alright, just a minute, let me dispatch this then, don't talk. Alright, any, are there any objections? Just once today I'd like to handle it right. Okay, question is then if there are no objections then 378 is returned. When we get it back then you can talk--alright. All those in favor--alright, Senator Schmit. We got, now we got it before us, now you can make your motion to do--

CLERK: Mr. President, reads motion.

PRESIDENT: Alright, Senator Keyes, Schmit, excuse me.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and Members of the Legislature. The amendment is on your desk. The original amendment which we proposed had some problems insofar as the language was concerned. This provides that the display cases which offer synthetic products for sale that are similitons of meat or meat products would be identified and placed separately and they would be conspicuously signed so that there would be no confusion of the public. It's a consumer protection bill and I move the amendment be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion now of the amendment--or motion? Senator Kelly? Motion is to return the bill--final reading. Any further discussion? Senator Keyes, did you want to be heard on the discussion here to return the bill? Why is your light on? Thank you. Question is shall 378 be returned from final to select file for a specific amendment? All those in favor of returning the bill vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Senator Schmit's motion is to return LB 378 from final reading to select file for a specific amendment. That still requires 25 votes. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: Mike off.

PRESIDENT: Bill is returned. Senator Schmit, back to you.
