

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor will vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Clerk will record.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 42 ayes, 0 nays, 7 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. Attention please, the final reading of LB 560.

CLERK: LB 560. (Read)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor will vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Clerk will record.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 41 ayes, 0 nays, 8 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. Senator Keyes, Senator Keyes, voting aye. Attention please, the final reading of LB 561.

CLERK: LB 561. (Read)

PRESIDENT: Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: How come we are passing over 149?

PRESIDENT: We are passing over 149 Senator Kremer, it is the chair's understanding in that the apparently the fiscal analysts staff indicated there was a fiscal impact of 149. Senator Kremer. Senator Kremer, go ahead sir.

SENATOR KREMER: I can't understand that.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kremer, have you, can you punch the switch on your microphone, up above. I wonder if that has been switched off. Your not coming through. All right, Senator Kremer, the chair is advised that Ellen will try to visit with you about the bill. Attention please, the final reading of LB 550.

CLERK: LB 550.---

PRESIDENT: Excuse me, Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: A point of order on 149. If there is a fiscal impact, I don't think it is materially because there is no A bill and there won't be this session, and I see no reason, this is a highly important bill in the field of agriculture. Now it may be that we have adopted a procedure to not pass any bill, whether it is an A bill either now or in the future might be attached. At that point, what can we do in order to undo that, in this particular instance if that is desirable?

PRESIDENT: I presume, you could make it unanimous consent, motion to go ahead and read 149 if that doesn't pass, if someone objects, fine. Just make a motion then we read the bill.

SENATOR CARPENTER: But are we in agreement that there is no money involved, in this bill which in any case had to be supplemented by an A bill, which is impossible this session when appropriation in January. Anyway, I ask unanimous consent, we read the bill with the understanding there is no appropriation in it. No A bill obviously can be introduced and if there is any money available it will have to be next January.
