CLERK: Reads vote. 38 ayes, 2 nays, 9 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed with the emergency clause attached. Attention please the final reading of LB 505.

CLERK: Reads bill. LB 505.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Reads vote. 42 ayes, no nays, 7 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed with the emergency clause attached. Chair recognizes Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: Mr. President and Members of the Legislature. A member of the fiscal staff, probably the-- Mr. Eldin Ehrlich, I believe, came to me this morning and said that there was a cost factor in 534 and I would move, ask unanimous consent that we read 534. The cost in that bill is somewhat under \$9,000. As I recall, the cost is \$8100 but it--I can assure you it is under \$9,000. I do not understand why there is a cost factor there but according to his figures, his sources, it will be, it will be like, somewhat similar to LB 149 which we did read this morning with unanimous consent and I think that figure was possibly ten times greater, \$85,000 and so I ask unanimous consent that we do read 534 with that understanding.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to reading 534? Senator Simpson. Senator Simpson objects. Senator Burbach do you want to make a motion then? There was an objection unanimous consent.

SENATOR BURBACH: I so move.

PRESIDENT: Motion before us then is shall we read LB 534? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Chair would rule that does take 25 votes. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 3 nays, remainder not voting.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries, we will read LB 534. Attention please, the final reading of LB 534.
