SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm going to have to ask for a call of the house because I see some empty chairs of those who support it.

PRESIDENT: Alright. Senator Chambers asking for a call of the house. Clerk will clear the board. At the next bell, please indicate your support of a call of the house. Motion is for a call of the house. Thank you. Clerk will record. We are now--

CLERK: 28 ayes, 2 nays on call of the house, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We are now under a call of the house.

CLERK: Senator Carpenter voting aye on the original motion.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter voting aye, Senator Stromer voting aye. Excuse me--

CLERK: Senator Stromer voting no.

PRESIDENT: Voting no. Alright--Senator--excuse me. Senator Lewis voting no.

CLERK: Senator which Lewis?

PRESIDENT: Richard Lewis.

CLERK: Senator Richard Lewis voting no.

PRESIDENT: Senator F. Lewis voting aye. Motion under vote is shall we unbracket LB 235 and 235A and the motion is for unbracketing only. We are under call of the house. Senator Barnett, we're under call of the house. Would you take your seat. At the next bell please indicate your presence. We're under call of the house. We're trying to determine who's absent. The motion under vote is the unbracketing of LB 235 and 235A.

CLERK: Senator DeCamp voting aye on the original motion.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp voting aye. Senator Keyes, we're under call of the house. Take your seat, please. We apparently still have five members missing. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I move that the call be raised.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to raise the call. All those in favor of raising the call vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Thank you. Clerk will record. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, no nays, 18 not voting to raise the call.

PRESIDENT: Call is raised. Let's have the tally on the original vote, to unbracket the bills.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President.
