SPEAKER: Committee amendments, all right then you have moved for the adoption of the committee amendments. Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: This amendment, may I ask Senator Hasebroock a question? It just simply puts it in the spring election rather than the fall election isn't that correct?

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: It changes it from the fall election to the May election.

SPEAKER: Is this just one amendment Senator Hasebroock?

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: Yes

SPEAKER: Are you ready....Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: I have a question of Senator Hasebroock. Senator Hasebroock, in section 10 of that bill it states in there that the legislature shall convene every first Tuesday of the year on January 1st like we had this happen this year. Could we amend this bill to take care of this problem at the same time? I say this so that we don't have to meet on January 1st in the future on a holiday and waste a day like we did yesterday.

SPEAKER: The Chair suggests this possibility since we are having a little bit of trouble moving bills off of General File that we advance the bill if that is your desire and then offer an amendment on Select File.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: I understand that there is an amendment but of course this has to go as a Constitutional Amendment, but it could all be done at one time couldn't it Vince?

SENATOR BARNETT: This is what I'm thinking. I don't want to hinder either bill Mr. Speaker but I think that we could eliminate a problem of two constitutional amendments if we could put them together.

SPEAKER: Certainly the Chair agrees. It is just a matter of procedure then if you want to go ahead and advance the bill and put the amendment on later or if you want to offer the amendment now. I suppose that you don't have it written do you.

SENATOR BARNETT: No, I just noticed this in the bill and I was... If Senator Hasebroock would like, if he would hold it for about 10 minutes.-
