SPEAKER: Well what are to what point are you speaking.

SENATOR SYAS: I want to get excused.

SPEAKER: Sir?

SENATOR SYAS: It has nothing to do with the vote.

SPEAKER: Just a minute Senator Syas, Senator Chambers objecting here, the vote has been taken.

SENATOR SYAS: It has nothing to do...I'm not....I want to be excused this afternoon.

SPEAKER: Well I'm very sorry, but you can be excused. Are you objecting Senator Chambers? He is not objecting.

SENATOR SYAS: All I said was that me getting excused this afternoon has nothing to do with the vote, that is all that I said.

SPEAKER: Yes, we are all in agreement. Senator Chambers now what will you do with the bill.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I want to move that the bill as amended be advanced to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion? You heard the motion. All those in favor of advancing the bill. Is there an amendment Senator Chambers? As amended advancing the bill as amended vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 38 Ayes, 5 Nays, and 6 not voting Mr. President.

SPEAKER: The bill as amended is advanced. Now what is your pleasure?

CLERK: Mr. President I do have a motion to adjourn and I have some new bills that could be put in.

SPEAKER: How many do you have Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Five.

SPEAKER: PUT them in.

CLERK: Mr. President first I ask unanimous consent to withdraw LB78 on General File, signed, Senator Clark.

SPEAKER: That will be laid over.
