

SENATOR SIMPSON: Yes, it is a substitute section yes.

SENATOR WHITNEY: It is a substitute section and what your amendment then is that it is the bill, correct?

SENATOR SIMPSON: It would become the bill yes, and then the basis of the way it is set now it would only cover Lancaster County. My interest in this bill was for Lancaster County and I had some flack from the newspapers out-state and so I amend my amendment with that it would cover only Lancaster County. If the people from the outside areas in the state wish to be included then I would be happy to take a portion of Senator Richendifer's amendment that would include all counties. Douglas County is already in the unique position of not having to publish every month.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Then will there be anything left in the law pertaining to the other counties in the state?

PRESIDENT: Senator Simpson, do you care to respond?

SENATOR WHITNEY: Senator Simpson then would there be any other laws in our books which would pertain to the other counties in the state?

SENATOR SIMPSON: I couldn't answer the question Senator Whitney, I'm not sure.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: My amendments take care of that. Would you read my amendment?

CLERK: Read amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Yes, I have a question of Senator Richendifer now.

PRESIDENT: Senator Richendifer, yield?

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Yes.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Is your amendment an amendment to the section one that is presently in the statutes, or is it an amendment to.....

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Do you have your book open there, page 2 line 11.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Or is an amendment to Senator Simpson's amendment?

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Is page 2, line 11 in section 1 that is the only section that his deals with, section 1.

PRESIDENT: Senator Simpson.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Mr. President, I think that Senator Richendifer amendment's would be all inclusive to the section then as it now stands and seeing that, I would ask unanimous consent to withdraw my amendment and take up his.

PRESIDENT: Alright now, Senator Simpson is asking unanimous consent to then withdraw his amendment. Are there objections to the withdrawal of his amendment? Hearing none so ordered. We will take up the Richendifer amendment unless there were other Simpson amendments at this time. Stand by, we have a
