PRESIDENT: Very good. The motion before the body at this time is to bracket the bill only. That precludes discussion of the bill. We are just bracketing. Senator Nore.

SENATOR NORE: Instead of contacting the lawyers association or the bar association, or the trial lawyers association, I think that we had better contact our constituents. Senator Luedtke represents the trial lawyers association both state and nationally. Indirectly, I don't know if then he gets a retainers fee or not, do you? OK, I didn't think that they did, but I think that we had better contact constituents.

PRESIDENT: Motion before the body is to bracket the bill. All those in favor of bracketing 520 vote aye, those opposed vote no. Motion is to bracket 520 for a week. Have you all voted? Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 Ayes, 12 nays and 12 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Bill is bracketed.

CLERK: Mr. President we have two new bills, LB682 (read) LB683 (read), Mr. President I move that we adjourn until 9:00 signed, Senator Whitney.

PRESIDENT: Stand by, any further business? Senator Stull your light is on did you wish to be recognized? Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: Mr. President, members of the legislature I would like to have an executive session of the Revenue Committee at 1:30 this afternoon. Senator Schmit made a similar request for 2:00, I think that there are 3 or 4 of our members that are members of both committees of Revenue and Agriculture. Visiting with Senator Schmit since our discussion on the floor this morning it is agreeable with him that the Revenue Committee meet at 1:30 and the Agriculture Committee meet as soon as we are completed with our work at approximately 3:00.

PRESIDENT: Any other business now to come before the body? Senator Keyes, do you have an announcement of some kind?

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. President, I would like to bracket LB91. Until a more opportune time.

PRESIDENT: Motion is....

SENATOR KEYES: I guarantee it or one similar to it will come up this session of the legislature.

PRESIDENT: Senator Keyes is asking unanimous consent to bracket LB91. Are there any objections? Hearing....
