SENATOR KENNEDY: Yes, and then leave section 17 on page 21.

SENATOR KELLY: O.K., thank you very much senator.

SENATOR KENNEDY: Yes, are there any other questions?

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the committee amendments now to LB513 as explained by Senator Kennedy?

SENATOR KENNEDY: If not, I ask that the committee amendments be adopted?

PRESIDENT: The motion now is to adopt the committee amendments. All those in favor of adopting the amendments say aye, those opposed say no? So ordered, the committee amendments are adopted.

SENATOR KENNEDY: Then I ask that the bill be advanced to E & R, as amended?

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion to LB513? Any further discussion? Senator Whitney?

SENATOR WHITNEY: A question, Mr. President, of Senator Kennedy.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kennedy, will you yield please?

SENATOR KENNEDY: Yes.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Now, if you leave section 17 in tact, would you not also have to revise section 17 in order not to strike all of these sections that you were attempting to revise? I would think that you would have to ask the bill writer to make some changes there in section 17?

SENATOR KENNEDY: I believe that maybe you are correct, I was going to according to the bill drafter's instruction.

SENATOR WHITNEY: The bill drafter could probably take care of that on E & R initial, but I would like for you to mention that to him.

SENATOR KENNEDY: I think that probably on the tenth paragraph on our amendments probably takes care of that on page 21. Yes, it should be, it has been taken care of in item 10 in page 21 line 7 strike two and then insert 71-2018 and strike lines 8 and insert 71-2037 in line 9 and I think that takes care of it. Did you get that Senator Whitney? O.K., yes thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kennedy, I was momentarily distracted, did you make a motion that that change be made now?

SENATOR KENNEDY: No, it is already in there and I was just clarifying it to Senator Whitney, so I would ask that the committee amendments, as written, and as accepted, and the bill 513 be advanced to E & R?

PRESIDENT: O.K., any further discussion now of LB513? Question is, shall LB513 be, as amended, be advanced from General File to E & R initial, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. You are voting on the advancement of LB513 from General File to E & R initial. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, no nays, 18 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. That brings up LB565, Senator Syas, are you ready on that one?
