PRESIDENT: Will the Legislature please come to order, we will have prayer by the Chaplain. We have Reverend Everet Hesmaul substituting this morning for Chaplain Palmer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer.

PRESIDENT: Roll call

CLERK: Called the roll.

PRESIDENT: ONce again the Chair would like to inquire if you have all indicated your presence? Once again have you all registered? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Quorum present Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are there corrections for the JOurnal?

CLERK: None Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Do we have any petitions or memorials?

CLERK: None Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We must have some notices of committees or reports.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Stand by, just a minute. Stand by just a minute. We are ready for Final Reading so we would ask that the floor be cleared, and the Senators get into their seats in preparation for Final Reading. While we are arriving at that spot, the Chair would like the privilege of introducing 40 students from Havelock School that are seated in the South Balcony. Their instructor is Linstrum Snyder and they are from Harold Simpson's district. We are delighted to have you here this morning to observe the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature.
