

PRESIDENT: Stand by. Senator Stanmer do you care to respond.

SENATOR STAMMER: I'm not trying to be nip picking here I am trying to improve the bill as it currently stands. I think that the attorney general and the bill drafter both are not or we wouldn't be in the bind that we are now with Senator Chambers in his Lt. It will probably get it more votes out-state and help pass it.
