PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion of the bill? The question is then should LB 128 be indefinitely.. Senator Stromer did you want to be heard on the issue. The question is shall Lbl28 be indefinitely postponed. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Once again have you all voted? Have you all voted. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 20 nays.

PRESIDENT: LB 128 is indefinitely postponed. Brings up General File debate. Looks like LR19. Yes, if we have motions up there unbracket bills, lets take them.

CLERK: We ask unanimous consent to unbracket LB 377. (Signed) Senator Simpson.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to unbracketing LB 377. Hearing none. So ordered.

CLERK LB377 read. There is a Richendifer amendment which is considered. And there was a Simpson amendment that was considered and adopted. There is a Richendifer amendment. Two Richendifer amendments pending, Mr. President and there are some Simpson amendments pending.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Mr. President I would ask for unanimous consent to withdraw my amendments.

PRESIDENT: Both amendments Senator. Senator Richendifer asking unanimous consent to withdraw two amendments to LB 377. Are there objections to the withdrawal of the amendments. Senator Kelly do you object. Senator Kelly is your microphone turned off up above there. Let's try that again.

SENATOR KELLY: I would like to have the amendments read. That we are going to strike. The one's asking to withdraw I'd like to have those read.

CLERK: They are on page 132 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Do you withdraw your objection

SENATOR KELLY: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Anderson are you objecting to the withdrawal of the two amendments?

SENATOR ANDERSON: Let me clarify something by asking if Senator Richendifer would yield.

PRESIDENT: Senator Richendifer will you yield to a question?

SENATOR ANDERSON: One of the amendments that you are wanting to withdraw is the amendment which would allow each of the counties to aggregate their claims and publish..aggregate each of their salary claims and publish the amount of salary once a year is that correct.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: That's correct.

SENATOR ANDERSON: So if you do withdraw your amendment. Then we're back to Senator Simpson amendment that allows this only for Lancaster County is that right?
