SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Let me clarify this for you. I got together with Senator Simpson and we worked this out to the amendment that does just exactly what you want it to do. This is the reason for the withdrawal for my amendment. The amendments that he has that he would like to have put on does the same thing as my amendment.

SENATOR ANDERSON: O.K. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Now are there any objections to the withdrawal of the Richendifer amendment? Hearing none. So ordered then those amendments are withdrawn. Are there other amendments now to the..

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President. Senator Carpenter has an amendment to strike the words "shall" and insert "may". This was printed in the Journal on January 2. Senator Carpenter.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter. We're ready to your amendment to LB377. The clerk will read your..

SENATOR CARPENTER: I ask unanimous consent to withdraw my amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter asking unanimous consent to withdraw that amendment. Are there objections? Any objections. Hearing none. So ordered. Amendment is withdrawn. Are there other amendments.

CLERK: Well, Mr. President the next one is by Senator Simpson.

PRESIDENT: The chair recognizes Senator Simpson.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I move to adopt the amendments. Now this amendment would strike this section as now amended, and would start fresh. And it would do I think what everyone here is concerned about. And first of all it would allow that the aggregate amount of all payroll claims could be included as one item. And the other provision, and this is for all counties below two hundred thousand and I'll read the other portion. Provided, between July 15 and August 15 of each year the names of all employees and their current annual, monthly, or hourly salaries shall be published and any changes in salaries or the hiring of new employees during the calendar quarter preceeding the months of October, January, and April shall be published during the months of November, February, and May. And I'll tell you what this does it allows the county to make a total of all their payroll claims as one total figure. Then once a year between the time of July 15 and August 15 they will show all employees who are on the payroll and what their current salary is. As there on other changes at the end of each FICA quarter it would show on their Form 941. It would take these off, and the changes would be published so the people would know each three months, the changes in salaries or new employees hired. With this explanation I move adoption of this amendment.
