SENATOR HASEBROOCK: Mr. President, I would like to ask Senator Simpson a question.

PRESIDENT: Does Senator Simpson yield.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Yes.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: Senator Simpson, I understand that the salaries that instead of being itemized for everyone that gets a salary of how much monthly. It would be done once a year, or if there were any corrections made, or any new people put on the payroll is this the idea. The otherwise the total amount will be given every month. So much for salaries.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Show all the total of all payroll claims. On the middle of the year. And the reason this was taken was because this was budget time people are getting their increases in the new budget and at that time they would show the amount of money each person would earn. Then other than that three or four times a year they would have to show if there were changes in any of the personnel's salary or if they hired new people at what salary.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Now, any further discussion of LB 377 as amended. Any further discussion. Senator Nore you have spoken twice on the bill.

SENATOR NORE: I would just like to make one statement. I'd sure like to see it in writing that the Nebraska Press Association, especially our strong newspapers are for this bill. I just can't see why they would be.

PRESIDENT: Senator Simpson, do you care to respond.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Mr. President, and to Senator Nore. I wonder if you would take my word that I met with them and they agreed on this language. The president of the association was with us, and also the..almost all the other officers were in this meeting.

PRESIDENT: Senator Simpson do you have any closing?

SENATOR SIMPSON: No closing.

PRESIDENT: The question is shall LB 377 as amended be advanced. Excuse me. Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Yes, I had a question of Senator Simpson. As I recall at the present time a good many of the school districts, do not inform the public through advertising in the papers. The costs of salaries, and so on. Now would this bill expand this whole program and include the school districts, or not.

SENATOR SIMPSON: No, it would not include the school districts.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Keys do you wish to be heard on the bill. I can't hear you, Sir. Thank you. Once again then. The question is, shall LB 377 be advanced as amended from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor will vote aye, all those opposed will vote no.
