

PRESIDENT: OK, Clerk will clear the board. At the next bell please indicate your preference for a call of the house. All of those in favor of a call of the house vote aye those opposed vote no. (1) it provides for compensation for the disconnection of electrical service to the signs that have electrical service along the Interstate and the primary roads. (2) The exempt signs located on premisses along these primary highways provided the sign is within 50 feet of the industrial or commercial operation. (3) It changes the provision for the fee to be assessed for the permit to a \$15 fee and it renews the offense for each days violation. (4) It provides that these fees can be collected annually.
