SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President I move that LB594 be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion to advance LB594 from Select File. All those in favor of advancing the bill please say aye, those opposed say no. Bill is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President I move that LB595 be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion to advance LB595. All those in favor of advancing the bill please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the bill is advanced.
