CLERK: Voting aye, Senators Anderson, Barnett, Carpenter, F. Carstens, Cavanaugh, Chambers, Clark, DeCamp, Duis, Fellman, Kelly, Kremer, R. Lewis, Luedtke, Mahoney, Maresh, Marsh, Marvel, Nore, Rasmussen, Schmit, Simpson, Skarda, Waldron and Whitney. Voting nay, Senators Burbach, Dickinson, Epke, Goodrich, F. Lewis, Moylan, Murphy, Savage, Snyder, Stromer, Syas. Not voting Senators C. Carsten, Fowler, Hasebroock, Johnson, Kennedy, Keyes, Kime, Proud, Richendifer, Stahmer, Stull, Warner and Wiltse. 25 ayes, 11 nays, and 13 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. Before we go on with the Final reading of LB389 the Chair would like the special privilege of introducing 57 Japanese students that are seated in the north balcony this day. They are here studying animal and poultry science and a special three month course in the Animal Science Department at the University of Nebraska here in Lincoln. They spend the last year and will return to Japan next summer to apply their knew knowledge of American agriculture to food production in Japan. We are very pleased to have you here as guests here in the Unicameral Legislature Chamber. We will see you out at the college sometime when the program is pulled off later on this year.
