CLERK: 30 ayes, no nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: The rules are suspended and we are ready to take up Final Reading. The first bill on Final Reading, well it's LR 8. The clerk will read.

CLERK: LR 8 (read)

SPEAKER: Is that the entire resolution.

CLERK: That's all Mr. President.

SPEAKER: All those in favor vote aye, all opposed vote no.

CLERK: Senator Savage voting aye.

SPEAKER: Have you allvoted. The clerk will record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 9 nays, 8 not voting.

SPEAKER: The resolution is passed. The next bill is LB 43
The Clerk will read. Senator Syas.

SPEAKER: Well, Mr. Clerk won't that be printed in the Journal. It will be printed in the Journal, so I assume that as a record vote. The clerk will read the next bill.

CLERK: Engrossed LB 43 (read)

SPEAKER: All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no.
Have you all voted. The clerk will record.

CLERK: 43 ayes, no nays and 6 not voting.

SPEAKER: Mr. Clerk the Chairman of the Rules Committee has reminded me that on that Resolution since it is handled as a bill the names should be read. Can you now read those names.

CLERK: Voting read on LR 8.

SPEAKER: LB 43A, Clerk will read.

CLERK: Reengrossed bill 43A (read)

SPEAKER: Question on this bill before he gets the final vote. It has a date and it also has an emergency clause on it. I'm wondering what would..does this put us in a delemma on this bill or not.

SPEAKER: No the bill goes into affect as signed by the Governor but just that way as the bill read, and if it reads that it doesn't take affect, doesn't actually go into operation until a certain date I presume that is the way it is. Would you agree with that Mr. Clerk.
