SPEAKER: The amendment is adopted. The Clerk will read Senator Syas last amendment.

CLERK: The last amendment, Mr. President, is again found on page 313 (read)

SENATOR SYAS: Well, I move that that one be adopted, and this came up in the date and I said all along that my intention was to have the state reimburse any county or school district for their tax loss. Which I think will be very minimal. But I got flack on it from the floor that I didn't specifically say so which I was following exactly what we had done in the past, which we didn't specifically say so on Homestead Exemption and all that. CLERK: 25 ayes, 4 nays and 20 not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR SYAS: All right, I move that the bill as adopted be advanced.

SPEAKER: Mr. Clerk, the amendments are adopted. Are there further amendments.

CLERK; None.

SPEAKER: You have moved that the bill be advanced as amended All those in favor say aye, opposed say no. The bill is advanced. The next bill on Select File is LB 66. Senator has moved that the bill.
