

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature. These are election bills they belong in the Government Committee. Last year when the Secretary of State had an entire bundle he did not separate them according to subject matter. Some dealt with municipal elections, and some with county elections and some with primary, some with school boards and so forth. The Government Committee is the proper place for this for these bills and they introduce as according to statements they made earlier have all but abandoned them so I think that they ought to be re-referred to the proper committee and that is why I ask for unanimous consent. If that fails I make a motion.

SPEAKER: Is there an objection to that?

SENATOR SYAS: Make a motion because I object.

SPEAKER: He made his motion, are you objecting Senator Syas? Now Senator Goodrich. Senator Chambers has now moved that these bills be re-referred from education to government. Senator Syas.

SENATOR SYAS: I won't tie you up. The reason that I have is because Senator Chambers is correct, tomorrow I was going to stand up on this floor and ask for the withdrawal. He has now on the bills and I figured that I would get....I couldn't get unanimous consent to withdraw these bills one by one which I think that each one of us the introducers were are going to do therefore I know that tomorrow I have to move to withdraw them and if that happens there is no use in assigning them to any place. I think that they have been assigned, so lets have the public hearing where they are assigned.

SPEAKER: Are these the elections by districts, Senator?

SENATOR SYAS: Yes they are and as I say I was going to ask for the withdrawal. Now, if the Senators do not want them withdrawn they should vote for differently than what I am telling but I am going to ask to have them withdrawn. I can't because he has a motion. Senator Stull says why don't I do it right now, I say I can't because he has a motion pending.

SPEAKER: Senator Barnett. Mr. Chairman I guess I would like to ask Senator Syas a question. Are these four bills we are talking about is there anything that includes Omaha now in these bills?

SENATOR SYAS: No, I don't think so.

SENATOR BARNETT: Thank you.

SPEAKER: Are you ready for the question? Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR SYAS: Wait a minute, wait a minute, I don't want to mis...answer wrong, are you talking about the Omaha School District or are you talking about Omaha? Omaha School District No, but there is something in there that does pertain to Omaha. That is some of the class three's.

SPEAKER: Senator Dickinson.
