Number one, teach them, for example, in the lambing season how to confine their lambs so that they can alleviate the depredation problem. And number two, teaching these stock-growers how to deal with individual specific predators that are causing the problem, rather than just attempting to wipe out the entire population. And so I think LB 699 does give us a tool to deal with the problem now, but I think that we shouldn't assume that this will solve the problem, and we should keep looking at more effective and realistic way of dealing our agricultural depredation problem.
