This is an auditing problem. There is nothing in the statutes that allows for a cash fund for the operation of the station and yet it is the only way in which you can be fiscally sound in operating this sort of a service station out of the Kearney Institution. So this is something that the Department of Corrections needs. 1525 is the harmonizing statutes with the age requirements relative to the Youth Development Center and this merely goes to the legal age which we have already changed. So that's almost a revisor's bill in that sense. 1526 is the result of LB563 in the last session which set up a separate Department of Correctional Services and the transfer of buildings from the Department of Public Institutions to the Department of Public Institutions and Correctional Services and vice versa. We have one going back the other way and one coming, two coming from the Department of Public Institutions. This is a matter between the departments but it takes statutory authorization to do it. And then LB1527 merely changes the name of the State Reformatory for Women to the Nebraska Center for Women. That is merely a nomenclator a name change.
