

rules and to introduce all four bills at once, so that we don't have to debate four different times. Now the question is shall the rules be suspended and the four bills be introduced? Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I think probably that will have to be a ruling from the Chair then. Then your ruling will stand in case that no one objects to the ruling.

PRESIDENT: Well the chair was going to test the water and see if we could get away with it anyway. The question is shall the rules be suspended and the four bills introduced. All those in favor of suspending the rules for the introduction of the four bills vote aye, those opposed vote no. Motion is to suspend the rules and introduce the four bills as explained and outlined by Senator Luedtke. That motion does require 30 votes. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 1 nay and 18 not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Till bill is introduced, excuse me, Clerk read the title.

CLERK: Read LB990, LB991, LB992, LB993, and LB994. Read report from Banking and Insurance Committee report read. Unanimous consent request by Senator Stahmer, read.

PRESIDENT: Lay it over.

CLERK: Read unanimous consent from Senator Warner.

PRESIDENT: Any objections? Hearing none so ordered. Senator Barnett, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Senator Carpenter asked me to find out some information for him and I talked to him about it. The point system in the motor vehicle department or for your driving in the state of Nebraska is set by statutes 39-7128. They were first adopted in 1953 and the last time they had been looked into was in 1967. So I pass that piece of information on to the body.

PRESIDENT: Thank you Senator Barnett.

CLERK: Read a request by Senator Syas regarding LB900.

PRESIDENT: Just a second please, the Chair would like to take up the consideration of bills on Select File before we go to the motions there on that one if you don't mind. It seems important that we have two bills up there a that were to be expedited in the interest of expedition it seems that we should do that. Senator Cavanaugh in the Chamber?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Do you have the page?

PRESIDENT: Stand by.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I've got it. I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB592.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to LB592. All those in favor of adopting the amendments please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendments are adopted.
