CLERK: (Read LB438.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? That is about as close to unanimity as you can get.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed with the emergency clause attached. Attention please, the Final Reading of LB508.

CLERK: (Read LB508.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Voting on the final passage of LB508, and the Chair would inquire have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: (Refer to journal, page 414.) 47 ayes, 1 nay, 1 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. Attention please, the Final Reading of LB513.

CLERK: Motion on the desk Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion.

CLERK: I move to bracket LB513 for one week, signed Senator Goodrich.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Goodrich for his motion.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President and members of the body.
