CLERK: 26 ayes, 10 nays to raise the call.

PRESIDENT: The call is raised. Roll call vote on the original motion. The motion is to introduce the bill.

CLERK: Roll call (Page 415 Journal) 24 ayes, 22 nays and 3 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The motion is lost.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move for the introduction of the attached bill. (Signed) Senator Warner. It's a bill for an act relating to school, to clarify provisions and repeal the original section.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner for his motion.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President. This bill is brought to us by one of the members of the committee. What it would do is, the present law the children who are bussed, or rather who are not bussed that receive transportation in some instances. Apparently they stay in town and are not actually bussed and continue to collect. What the bill does is to restrict transportation costs to miles actually traveled rather than what happens in some cases at this time.

PRESIDENT: Are there any further discussion of this bill. Any further discussion of the bill on the motion to introduce the bill. The question is then shall the bill as explained by Senator Warner be introduced. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. We are voting on Senator Warner's motion to introduce the bill as explained by Senator Warner. The question is, have you all voted? Once again, the chair would inquire if you have all voted? The chair is not in a position to lobby for votes, but this question takes 30 votes. Have you all voted. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, no nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is introduced. Are there other bills for introduction.

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Read the titles of the bills.

CLERK: New bills, Mr. President. LB 995 (read by Clerk) LB 996 (read by Clerk). Mr. President we have a series of Committee Hearings that I would like to read to you. Mr. President your Committee on Urban Affairs has given notice of hearing for February 6 and February 13 (Signed) Senator Snyder, Chairman. The committee on Public Works gives notice of a hearing on February 13 (Signed) Senator Kremer, Chairman Mr. Chairman on Banking Commerce and Insurance heard LB 612 and instructs me to report the same be advanced to General File as amended. (Signed) Senator Fred Carstens, Chairman. Mr. President your Committee on Agriculture and Environment who as referred LB 674 and instructs me to report the same be advanced to General File as amended (signed) Senator Schmit, Chairman. Mr. President your Committee on Constitutional Revision and Recreation instructs me to report LB 649 to General File, (signed) Senator Anderson Vice-Chairman.
