PRESIDENT: Will the Legislature please come to order. We will now have prayer by Chaplain Palmer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer given.

PRESIDENT: Roll call. Please indicate your presence. Have you all indicated your presence? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Are there corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: The spelling of the word "eligible" on page 409, line 27. That's all, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are there additional corrections from the floor? If not, the Journal will stand as corrected. Are there petitions or memorials?

CLERK: I have a communications from the Executive Office. (Clerk read)

Mr. President we have an Attorney General's opinion which will be inserted in the Journal in full, addressed to Senator Duke Snyder.

Mr. President your committee on Commerce, Banking and Insurance to whom was referred LB 968 instructs me to report the same legislative recommendation be postponed (Signed) Senator Carstens, Chairman.

Mr. President your Enrolling Clerk reports that on this day at 9:00 presents the Governor for his approval LB 66 (Signed) Barbara Jackson, Enrollment Clerk.

Mr. President your Chairman on Enrollment and Review reports that we have examined and reviewed LB 359 and find the same correctly Engrossed. LB 599 correctly Engrossed.

Mr. President your Committee Enrollment and Review reports that we have examined and reviewed LB 438 and find the same correctly Enrolled. LB 508 correctly Enrolled. LB 595 correctly Enrolled. (Signed) John Cavanaugh, Chairman.

PRESIDENT: While Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business I'm signing LB 438. Also LB 508 and LB 595.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Government, Military and Veteran's Affairs to whom was referred LB 621 instructs me to report the same legislative recommendation be advanced to General File as amended. LB 622 General File as amended and 689 General File as amended. (Signed) Senator Chambers, Chairman. That's all.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. We have no bills for Final Reading today. So that would move us then on to resolutions. Are there resolutions on the desk.

PRESIDENT: Are there any bills for introduction?

CLERK: Mr. President, I move for the introduction of the attached bill (Signed) Senator Kennedy. It's a bill for an enactment pertaining to Education to provide resident physician education programs throughout the state.
