SENATOR MARESH: I think we are not only talking about human lives we are also talking about livestock and other property.

SENATOR DECAMP: That's correct.

SENATOR MARESH: It's very difficult for hunters to..you know especially if they are strange in an area to determine where the boundary is, and I can't see how they could abide by this amendment of yours if they didn't know whose land the property..I mean who was owner of the property.

SENATOR DECAMP: Maybe this would put the burden on them then to be at least hunting with or associated with some local hunters who did know the area.

PRESIDENT: The Chair next recognizes Senator Frank Lewis.

SENATOR FRANK LEWIS: I move the previous question, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The previous question has been moved. Does the Chair see 5 hands? The question is: Shall the debate now close on the amendment? All those in favor of closing debate vote aye, all those opposed vote no. This vote is only to close debate. The questions is: Shall the debate now close? Thank you. The Clerk will record. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 6 nays to cease debate.

PRESIDENT: Debate will not close. Senator DeCamp may close on his motion. Which is to return LB 699 to Select File for the specific amendment which he has already had printed in the Journal on page 490. Senator DeCamp is closing.

SENATOR DECAMP: The amendment has been explained. And it's merely to protect farmers, the people who live on these farmsteads, while still granting these people the right to hunt the coyotes, and still not killing the bill.

PRESIDENT: The question is: Shall 699 be returned to Select File for the specific amendment. All those in favor of returning the bill will vote aye, all those opposed will vote no. This motion is to return LB 699 to Select File for the specific amendment. Have you all voted to return the bill? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to return, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: 699 is now on Select File. The next vote is your pleasure regarding the amendment. The question is: Shall the amendment be adopted then to 699 on Select File. All those in favor of adopting the amendment will vote aye. All those opposed will vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President on the motion to adopt.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp's amendment is adopted. Senator DeCamp what is your pleasure regarding the bill. The motion now is to readvance the bill as amended. Senator Syas.
